#### **VENEER PREPARATION**


A medium grit, round-ended diamond bur is used to remove a uniform thickness of facial enamel by joining the depth-cut grooves.


#### **INCISAL PREPARATION**

The diamond bur is angled to bevel the incisal edge.




## **CHAMFER MARGINS**

Correct preparations of the chamfer margins interproximally allow the appropriate bulk of porcelain.




- When <u>not</u> closing a diastema, <u>do not</u> break tooth contacts. Stop tooth reduction prior to breaking natural contacts.
- Uniform facial preparation is recommended.
